# **SUNDAY MORNING DETAILS**

**Nursery & Preschool**: A Nursery and a 2K preschool class are available in our children's area off the main lobby during the entire service. From their first days at Redeemer, infants (0-crawlers) encounter God through loving caregivers. Our two-year olds will hear a simple Bible lesson and be led in age-appropriate activities; all intended to point them to the love of God and the truths of the gospel message.

**Children's Church:** Following the Pastoral prayer, "We Pray for the Church and the World," children ages (3-5) are invited to a time of teaching in the children's area. Children are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary for the entire worship service. Clipboards are provided on the back table for them to use for coloring. Following the service, parents should come pick up their children from their respective classrooms.

Weekly Communion: We celebrate communion each week during our worship service.
